RESPONSIBILITIES

Lifeguards ensure the safety of our aquatic customers by scanning the pool, preventing accidents, enforcing the rules and appropriately responding to emergency situations. In addition lifeguards assist in teaching swimming skills to customers of all ages. All employees must attend preseason and in-service training sessions. Other duties as assigned by supervisor(s).

QUALIFICATIONS

The minimum age for Lifeguards is 15 years of age. Applicants who are under 15 years of age, must provide a valid work permit by the first day of work. Current Certification in American Red Cross is required in order work as a lifeguard. The ideal candidate will be mature, responsible and have a great attitude. The candidate should enjoy working with people and have the ability to effectively communicate with children and adults. Must enjoy working outside.
