Swim Instructor Seasonal Position

RESPONSIBILITIES

The swim instructor is responsible for the swimming instruction as assigned in the aquatics program according to current American Red Cross methods. Swim Lessons vary in length from 30 to 45 minutes and consists of eight classes and run Monday through Thursday. Under the direction and supervision of the Aquatics Coordinator, teaches swim lesson sessions, ensuring the safety and well-being of each child. Leads warm ups, skills, drills and appropriately demonstrates each skill to be performed. Performs regular safety checks and ensures swimming lesson is safe at all times. Helps to set up and break down stations and equipment in an organized manner. Arrives 15 minutes before first scheduled class of the day to familiarize self with the lesson plan and teaching stations.

QUALIFICATIONS

The minimum age for Swim Instructors is 15 years of age. The ideal candidate will be mature, responsible and have a great attitude. Previous experience in swimming is preferred. The candidate should enjoy working with children and have the ability to effectively communicate with children and adults.
