RESPONSIBILITIES

The Pool Attendant is the first-person patrons will come into contact with at our facility which means great customer service is a must to ensure that all patrons have a positive experience at our waterpark. The Pool Attendant is responsible to answer any questions, direct patrons to the appropriate facility amenities and areas, and handle money transactions and possess knowledge of all rules, regulations and fees of the facility. In addition, they will ensure safety of patrons as they enter and ride slides, serve and prepare concession items and work as a part of our safety team. Pool Attendants report any complaints, restocking of cash drawer or other problems or concerns to the aquatic coordinator or head lifeguard, and completes other duties as assigned by supervisor(s).

QUALIFICATIONS

The minimum age for Pool Attendants is 14 years of age. Applicants who are under 16 years of age, must provide a valid work permit by the first day of work. The ideal candidate will be mature, responsible and have a great attitude. The candidate should enjoy working with people and have the ability to effectively communicate with children and adults. Must also enjoy working outdoors.
