Upon calling 48 hours in advance, admission will be reduced by \$0.50 per person and adult supervisors will be admitted free. The City requires a ratio of one (1) adult supervisor for every eight (8) children. Parks & Recreation staff reserves the right to refuse group reservations due to scheduling conflicts. Special discounts apply only to approved groups.

Pirates' Hollow Waterpark Rules

- All patrons must have a season pool pass or pay the daily admission, even if not swimming.
- Swimming is not allowed in the diving well.
- Running and rough play, including but not limited to: dunking, pushing, riding on shoulders and spitting are not allowed.
- No rough play or jumping on one another.
- Nobody is allowed on anyone else's shoulders.
- No toys (rings, balls, floats, etc.).
- **No Carry Ins** allowed, and all food must be consumed in the concessions area, not on deck.
- Only US Coast Guard approved life vests are allowed in the pool, and the child must be within one arm's reach of their parent or supervisor.
- Non-Swimmers need to be in arms reach of parent or guardian.
- **Children wearing life vests are not allowed on slides or diving boards.**
- T-shirts worn in the pool need to be tucked in.
- **NO T-SHIRTS ON SLIDES OR DIVING BOARD UNLESS TUCKED IN (must be a swim shirt).**
- Lap lanes are for adults/high school age kids swimming laps. If people are not swimming laps, they cannot be in the lap lanes.
- Children who are good swimmers can use the lap lanes if no adults are using them.
- Only single riders can go down the slides. Guardians **cannot** catch little ones at the bottom. Must be 48" to go down both slides.
- No sitting on the geysers.
- No diving in the shallow end.
- Diving Board: Only one person on the board at a time. Only one bounce should be taken before entry. Entry should only be off the front of the board and only when the area below is clear and safe.
- Children 8 years old and under must be accompanied by someone at least 13 yrs old.
- No hanging on the lap lanes/ropes.
- No climbing on the fences or the landscaping rocks.
- Diaper changing is not permitted on the pool deck. This is a health concern for all patrons.
- Glass is prohibited from the pool.
- All patrons should shower prior to entering the pool area.
- Groups must abide by pool policies and all chaperones are responsible for conduct of the group
- Additional rules may be added by staff if deemed necessary.
